

GOVERNOR DODGE STATE PARK HORSE/GROUP CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

1. The horse campground and horse trails are open from May 1-November 15. Occasionally, heavy rains may cause trail closure to prevent injury or natural resource damage.
2. Eleven campsites may be reserved in advance. There are two 1st come/1st served group sites. There is no overflow camping provided. Once the designated campsites are occupied, other camping units will be turned away.
3. Each reservable campsite can accommodate a family camping party (a parent or parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests) or an unorganized group of not more than six persons. *NOTE: While site limit is six people, the campsite may not accommodate six horses due to size limitations of each site.
4. The small group site (#713) is \$40.00 per night. The large group site (#714) is \$40.00 per night. The smaller group site can accommodate a maximum of 12 people and the larger group site a maximum of 20 people. *NOTE: While site limit is 12 or 20 people, the campsite may not accommodate the same number of horses due to size limitations of each site.
5. No electricity is available. One wheeled camper per site, this includes horse trailers with living quarters. Maximum of 2 vehicles per site. Vehicles and trailers are restricted to the paved parking lot. **You are required to back up to your site.**
6. **Horses may only be tied to tether poles.**
7. Tether poles have been provided at each campsite as the preferred option to keep your horse(s) in the designated area at your campsite. Please bring your own tethering ropes. If you choose to use any other type of restraining device, including fencing of any kind, the following restrictions apply. There are 4 corner posts at your campsite. Your restraining device/fencing must remain within the inner dimensions of the 4 corner posts. Any horse(s) at your campsite must remain within the boundaries of the 4 corner posts. You will be asked to remove and/or reset any device or fencing that extends beyond the designated horse area. Horses are restricted to designated horse trails.
8. Anyone 16 years or older using the horse trails in Governor Dodge State Park must purchase a daily or annual state trail pass. Daily State Trail Pass is \$5.00. The Annual State Trail Pass is \$25.00.
9. Drinking water and pit toilets are available adjacent to the campground.
10. Please help us keep your campground clean. Each camper should pick up horse manure deposited on the parking lot or horse stalls. The manure can be placed in the unmowed areas behind your campsites. Recycling containers are located at the family campgrounds, and the park office. A trash container is located in the horse campground lot.
11. Please refer to the camper card you received upon check-in for additional park rules and regulations.
